FREEDOM HIGH SCHOOL


This week, our **CFHLA President / CEO Robert Agrusa** had the opportunity to meet with several Hospitality and Tourism students from **Freedom High School**.

We look forward to developing a new partnership with the teachers and students of Freedom High School!


