SPORTS BUSINESS JOURNAL NAMES ORLANDO A TOP 25 SPORTS BUSINESS CITY

The remainder of the country now knows what we already knew, that **Orlando is among the best when it comes to sports**.

Earlier this week, the <u>Sports Business Journal</u> named their top 50 Best Sports Business Cities, with Orlando claiming the #25 spot.

The top 50 Best Sports Business Cities are home to multiple tenured franchises, events, modern venues, sponsors, agencies, media partners and other critical vendors, located within reasonable proximity of each other, while also fostering a climate of support from their residents, businesses and local governments.

To come up with ranking, the Sports Business Journal, over the past seven months, analyzed nearly half a million bits of data across 377 markets that are the home of at least one professional or Division I college athletic program, or a permanent event. They created an algorithm that took into account quantitative and qualitative data, as well as interviews and sentiment analysis from nearly 100 industry veterans.
