Congratulations to **Elizabeth "Liz" Anderson**, Security Admin/Coordinator at the <u>Caribe Royale Orlando</u>, on receiving the **CFHLA Security & Service Award for the second quarter of 2023**.

Liz is the longest-tenured member of the Caribe Royale Security Department, with over 19 years of service.

In February, an emergency call came in for assistance regarding a contractor injury. However, this call came over the radio with such a sense of urgency and desperation in their voice, that before the dispatcher was done dispatching units to the scene, Liz had already jumped up from her desk and headed immediately to the area.

Upon arrival, several members of the contractor staff and Caribe Banquet staff stood in the area where the incident had just occurred. Based on the information gathered, the contractors were unloading trusses from their truck when one larger section became unstable and fell of the lift-gate, landing on one of the contractors lower leg resulting in a complete break of his tibia and fibula with his lower leg just dangling.

Unfazed by the injury, Liz immediately assessed the scene and took charge. She directed other arriving security officers on securing the scene to prevent vehicular traffic in the area, bring over additional emergency care

bags, and await Orange County Fire Rescue to arrive and lead them to the scene.

Liz knelt down next to the injured individual, providing care, concern, and comfort until Orange County Fire Rescue arrived. Once OCFR arrived on the scene, Liz stayed with the injured contractor and medics to assist until they could stabilize and immobilize his leg so he could be transported to the nearest trauma center, where he underwent multiple surgeries and long-term physical therapy.

Thank you, Liz, for your leadership and calm demeanor, in spite of a very challenging situation. We also thank you for your continued commitment, passion and dedication to the hospitality industry!
