

# **WATIONAL TRAVEL AND TOURISM WEEK**

This week, the Central Florida Hotel & Lodging Association was proud to celebrate the 40th Anniversary of **National Travel and Tourism Week** (May 7-13, 2023) by distributing pineapples — the official symbol of hospitality — and receiving several proclamations from <u>Orange County</u>, <u>Osceola</u> <u>County</u> and <u>Seminole County</u>.

Each of these proclamations recognized the importance of the tourism and hospitality industry, as well as its essential role in **stimulating our local economy, cultivating our vibrant community, creating quality job opportunities, and elevating the quality of life for our local residents every day**.

Also, Central Florida was once again recognized as the **most visited** destination in the United States, with more than <u>74 million visitors</u> in 2022! This resulted in more than <u>\$75 billion in positive economic impact</u> and supported <u>41 percent of the total regional workforce</u>.

Here are a few more significant facts about the impacts of tourism, within each county in Central Florida, over the past year:



#### Orange County

Once again, Orlando is the **most visited destination in the world**, with more than **74 million visitors who came to the destination in 2022.** 

Tourism within the Greater-Orlando area **generated \$67.1 billion in** economic impact, supported 31% of the workforce, and the <u>Orange</u> <u>County Convention Center</u> contributed \$3 billion in economic impact.



#### **Osceola County**

Tourism is the largest industry in Osceola County, generating over \$5.5 billion in annual economic impact and is responsible for over 45,000 jobs.

Additionally, Osceola County has now **grown to more than 55,000 overnight accommodations** within the county.



#### **Seminole County**

In 2022, Seminole County **surpassed Tourist Development Tax projections by 45%,** and **hotel occupancy rates increased by 18%**, demonstrating a significant rebound in the hospitality industry.

Furthermore, Seminole County **hosted 97 sporting and athletic events** in 2022 at the Boombah Sports Complex, Soldiers Creek Park & Sylvan Lake Park, which **generated \$65 million in total economic impact** for the county!

### VISIT ORLANDO ANNOUNCES 2022 VISITATION NUMBERS



As we close out National Travel and Tourism Week, we'd like to congratulate our partners at <u>Visit Orlando</u>, who made a MAJOR announcement at yesterday's Travel & Tourism Luncheon!

Last year, Orlando was proud to welcome **74 million visitors again to our region**, which **surpassed 2021 visitation by 15 million visitors (a 24% increase)!** With Orlando quickly rebounding, we have now nearly recovered to our pre-pandemic visitation levels of 2019, making Orlando the number-one destination once again!
