

HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS SEMINAR & SALES TAX HOLIDAY



In preparation for the upcoming hurricane season, the CFHLA Engineers
Council hosted their annual Hurricane Preparedness Seminar at the
Wyndham Orlando Resort International Drive (Thank You, Carl Rodgers,
General Manager) this week.

Thank you to the nearly 70 CFHLA Members who attended the seminar and had the opportunity to learn more about the **products and services offered** by ten of our allied member sponsors.

Attendees also heard from **Tony Mainolfi**, Chief Meteorologist at WESH 2 News, who provided a **2023 Hurricane Season Outlook**. We appreciate the continued partnership with Tony, as he has been providing his seasonal outlook at the seminar since 2015.

Additionally, as a reminder, today marks the start of a two-week sales tax holiday on disaster preparedness items that will end on June 9.

This sales tax holiday includes a variety of disaster preparedness items such as: flashlights up to \$40; radios up to \$50; tarpaulins at \$100 or less; anchor systems or tie-down kits worth \$100 or less; fuel tanks up to \$50; small batteries — AA, AAA, C, D, 6-volt or 9-volt, not car batteries — up to \$50; food storage cooler up to \$60; portable generators worth \$3,000 or less; and smoke detectors, carbon monoxide detectors and fire extinguishers up to \$70 each. Also, many common household items and goods related to pets will be tax-

exempt during the period as well.

COLIN MILLS NAMED GENERAL MANAGER AT SHERATON LAKE BUENA VISTA RESORT


Congratulations to **Colin Mills**, who was named the new General Manager of the **Sheraton Lake Buena Vista Resort** this week!

SURF'S UP! PIPELINE: THE SURF COASTER BREAKS INTO SEAWORLD'S LINEUP BEGINNING MAY 27TH

<u>SeaWorld Orlando's</u> all-new <u>Pipeline: The Surf Coaster</u> will have its grand-opening this Saturday May 27th, by commemorating with a special ceremony featuring a "beach-front" ribbon cutting.
