

TELL THE GOVERNOR YOU SUPPORT SB 280 - THE REGULATION OF VACATION RENTALS

Today, we need your help! One of the six main priorities which passed during the 2024 Florida Legislative Session, was the **statewide regulation of vacation rentals and advertising platforms**. CFHLA has partnered with the Florida Restaurant and Lodging Association (FRLA) and the Asian American Hotel Owners Association (AAHOA) to encourage Governor DeSantis to sign SB 280.

SB 280 creates a strong foundation for the statewide regulation of vacation rentals that will reduce unlicensed rentals, increase tax compliance, and

protect consumers. We will keep you updated on the progress of this bill and hope you will join our advocacy efforts.


