



CFHLA is thrilled to announce that Florida has claimed the prestigious title of the **No. 1 state for economic impact generated by sports tourism in 2023!** This remarkable achievement marks the first time ever that Florida has secured the top spot on this esteemed list.


The accolade comes from the **Sports ETA State of the Industry Report**, which has unveiled its Top 10 states in terms of economic impact generated by sports tourism for the year 2023. The ranking analysis utilized data provided by sports tourism industry stakeholders and economic data, showcasing the significant contributions of sports tourism to our state's economy.
