We are excited to continue to partner with SCPS, in support of their culinary and hospitality programs and our future workforce!



It is with heavy hearts that we bid farewell to two remarkable individuals who left an indelible mark on the Central Florida hospitality industry, Jay Hunt and Marty Hunter.

Jay Hunt, renowned for his dedication and leadership during his tenure with Massey Services, made significant contributions to CFHLA and our community for many years. Jay's visionary partnership with CFHLA and Dollar Tree Stores for the Spring Cares Collection Drive exemplified his commitment to the betterment of our community, bringing in over 62,000 items in 2015 and an astounding \$158,000 worth of donations in 2018. Additionally, Jay served as the Chair of the CFHLA Allied Relations Council Board in 2018 and was extremely involved in our Adopt-A-School program.

Jay was also named twice as Allied Member of the Month (2013 and 2018) and CFHLA Allied Member of the Year in 2014.

A service will be held in memory of Jay Hunt next Friday, February 16th at 10AM at Curlew Hills Memory Gardens in Palm Harbor.



Marty Hunter, a stalwart of the hospitality industry with over 30 years of service, enriched CFHLA as the Board Chair in 1987 and is credited with cofounding what is now the Governmental Affairs Committee. His legacy was further honored with his induction into the CFHLA Legends in 2015, a testament to his enduring impact.



As we mourn their passing, let us cherish the wonderful memories of Jay and Marty, whose passion and dedication continue to inspire us all. While they both will be missed, their legacies will live on forever in the hearts of each of those they touched within the hospitality industry and within our community.
