I-4 & Sand Lake Road Interchange Project

CFHLA would like to inform our members of a new traffic pattern at the Interstate 4 (I-4) and Sand Lake Road (State Road (S.R.) 482) interchange that will begin as soon as **today**, **Friday**, **March 8th**.

The interchange, a vital gateway to one of Central Florida's busiest tourist areas, will be modified to a diverging diamond interchange (DDI). A DDI is an innovative type of interchange that has been shown to improve safety, increase traffic efficiency, and be cost-effective. Unlike a conventional interchange, this new traffic pattern will move traffic on Sand Lake Road to the opposite side of the road at a first traffic light, eliminating left turns across traffic to access I-4, and will move traffic back onto the right side of Sand Lake Road at a second traffic light. This will increase capacity and improve the flow of traffic on Sand Lake Road.

While the Sand Lake Road DDI will go into effect soon, the I-4 and Sand Lake Road interchange project will continue to undergo improvements until its anticipated completion in 2027. It's important that motorists pay attention, eliminate distractions, and follow posted road signs and pavement markings to guide them through the interchange.

With improvements to the I-4 and Sand Lake Road interchange underway, we'd like to offer you tools that can help you stay informed about the construction project.

The design for this project is ongoing. The final configuration of the interchange will be similar to what is shown in this rendering, but small refinements are anticipated.
